The front door was open as we carried stock to and fro. Whilst I was outside my address and George inside the address, I was aware of Graham's vehicle pulling up outside the address. His vehicle is a silver Peugeot motor car. I cannot recall the registration. As the car neared me he mouthed something through his closed driver's side window. I could not hear what he was saying as his window was closed. He looked very angry and agitated. He then drove a short distance away around the market hall and came back down towards my address, parking up right behind George's vehicle outside my address. He then quickly got out of his car and ran into my house, through the open front door. I then immediately followed Graham as I did not want him in the house and feared for George's safety. He then cornered George in the front room, between the fireplace and the coffee table. I noted at this time that George looked pretty frightened and wanted to get past Graham, as he did not want any trouble. George is a very gentle and kind man, who does not look for trouble. He is also a very sick man at this time and has a number of medical conditions. Graham then said to George 'GET OUT OF MY HOUSE, YOU DIRTY SHIT. GET OUT OF MY HOUSE'

At this time Graham was right up against Georges face and was screaming at him to get out.
