Mr George Stoke-Vaughan dob 16/7/52 attended my surgery at [REDACTED] on 27th May 2008 with a black eye. He had sustained this on 25th May 2008 at approximately 6 – 7pm during an alleged assault where he was punched in the face.

When I saw him, he had a tender nose which had been bleeding, and a black eye. On examination, the medial aspect of his left eye socket was bruised with some evidence of a subconjunctival haemorrhage on the medial aspect of his left eye. The iris and pupil did not appear to be involved and his visual activity was not affected. He had a full range of movement of both eyes and fundoscopy was normal in his left eye. He was tender over the medial aspect of his zygoma and over both nasal bones but there was no evidence of a fracture. I diagnosed bruising to the eye and nose and advised over-the-counter analgesia.
