


WITNESS STATEMENT

On Sunday 25th May 2008 at approximately 6.30pm I was in the music shop on China Street, Llanidloes. I heard a noise outside and a woman's voice shouting "STOP IT" she sounded hysterical and kept repeating "STOP IT". After a while of hearing this I heard the same woman shout "SOMEBODY CALL THE POLICE", I then went to the front door of the shop to see what was happening. Whilst stood just outside the front door of the shop, I could see a man lying face down on the pavement outside number 5 China Street, which is next door to the music shop. This male was lying parallel to the kerb approximately 2 metres away from where I was stood, his face was turned towards the road so I could not see who it was, his arms were by his side and his legs were straight out behind him, he was not moving. Graham who lives at number 5 China Street, was stood near to the man who was on the floor and Graham's partner Julie was trying to restrain him, by pulling Graham away from the man on the floor. Graham said several times "HE ATTACKED ME FIRST" he also turned to Julie and said "YOU'VE BEEN SHAGGING HIM FOR MONTHS". Graham then pulled free from Julie and approached the male on the floor and then sat on the male's upper back and punched the male two or three times to the lower back area with his right clenched fist, the punches appeared to be full force but the male on the floor ^{did not do anything} did not move or make any noise that I can remember, he may have been unconscious. Whilst this was happening Julie, who was stood near to Graham and the male on the floor, asked me to contact the police, so I went back inside and contacted the police on the shop phone. I did not go outside again until the police arrived approximately 10 minutes later, when I went outside the male who was on the floor was gone and Graham was speaking to the police officer. I later provided my details to the police and have not seen Graham or Julie since.
