the shorter male and the taller male, facing the shorter male trying to calm him down. At this point I noticed that there was another male on the pavement just behind me, he said to the taller man to go and sit down, but the taller man said he was happier to stand. Throughout this time I remained about three to four foot away from the incident as I did not want to get caught up in a fight. I could also see at this point that the shorter man's shirt was ripped open at the front and he was waving a set of keys around. The female was shouting to the shorter man "YOU'VE DONE SOMETHING TO HIS HEAD" as she said this she sounded upset and shaken, she was also still creating a barrier between the shorter man from the taller man. The shorter man kept repeating "YOU'VE BEEN SHAGGING HIM FOR MONTHS" and calling the female a "WHORE". The taller man said to the shorter man words to the effect of "THIS IS WHAT YOUR LIKE WHEN YOUR BIPOLAR, YOU CHANGE FROM ONE MINUTE TO THE NEXT" he did not say this loudly hence I could not clearly everything he said, but he appeared very calm and lucid. I said to the taller man that he should seek medical attention as he almost seemed concussed. The shorter man suddenly calmed down, I think I became aware that there were other people in the street watching, and took a few steps back. The whole incident seemed to dissipate so I said to the female to make sure the taller man saw a doctor, I then had to leave as I had to go to work. I then left and did not have anything further to do with the incident.

The whole incident that I saw lasted no more than a few minutes, but it felt like a lot longer as I was so shocked that grown men were fighting in the street in the day. I would describe the taller man as white, about mid fifty's in age, medium build, about 5"10 in height, brown short hair, wearing dark clothing. I would describe the shorter man as white, about late forty's in age, stocky build, about 5"6 in height, ginger short hair, fair complexion, wearing a white shirt which was ripped open. It was still daylight and I had a clear and unobstructed view of what I saw, the closest I got to the males was three to four foot away and I would recognise them if I saw them again.
